

## **Subscribing to EMail & SPAM**

### **How do I subscribe to the MGA email?**

MGA members may be included in our list to receive periodic Announcements and Newsletters via Email. Mass email mailings are required by law to abide by anti-spam regulations and the MGA mailings are no exception. Thus, we send you an email and you must open an email from the MGA in order for your account to be active. The process is pretty simple.

1. Click on the link 'Subscribe to the Men's Golf Association Announcements' on the home page for the MGA.
2. Complete the required information on the 'Welcome to the Men's Golf Association at Ford's Colony Subscriber Management' page.
3. MGA emails will be sent to you at the email address you entered, if the emails are passed by your email server.
4. Your email server and email client must pass the email confirmation, that is, it is NOT identified as SPAM and deleted or stored somewhere unknowing to you.

### **How long will it be before I see the first MGA email?**

You can expect to receive an MGA email at the next mailing of a MGA Announcement or Newsletter.

### **When do I become active and confirmed to receive other MGA mailings?**

As soon as you open an MGA email, you will become active. The system detects that opening and automatically updates our database.

### **What can I do to insure I get the first email?**

Most times, just adding the MGA email address ([mga@fcmgagolf.org](mailto:mga@fcmgagolf.org)) to your address book either in your email client (Outlook, Outlook Express, Thunderbird, i.e.) or in your web mail address book will take care of this. If you want to check the settings, email the [MGA](#) and request a test email be sent.

If this doesn't work, you must disable all SPAM blockers on you email account. In many cases, SPAM blockers are set by the email host to prevent any spam from getting on the email server. You can do this by logging in to the email host account at your email provider, <http://www.cox.net>, <http://www.verizon.net>, <http://www.aol.com>, etc., going to your email account and editing any spam blocker setting.

#### Not a Nerd?

You can call your email provider support line and ask them to disable it for you.

You must also disable any SPAM blocker on your computer. In many cases, you can leave the SPAM blocker working, but identify the emails you'd like to receive.

### **How can I un-subscribe from receiving MGA emails?**

Simple, just click on the un-subscribe link in any email and your name will be removed from our database.
